



Professional Attendee Travel Grant

We are pleased to announce the 2026 Capstone Design Conference Travel Grant for professional attendees. The goal of the grant is to encourage attendees who would like to participate in CDC26 but have limited travel funds within their institutions.

Who should apply?

- New capstone faculty within the first 3 years of teaching Capstone
- PhD Students interested in teaching capstone design
- Industry folks intending to transition into a Capstone Design role

What will the travel grant cover?

- Registration, which includes meals during the conference
- Travel (either flight or mileage)

*If funded, the host institution will make the travel reservations and pay for them directly. There will be no reimbursement of the incidental expenses. Preference will be given to funding attendees with cost-sharing arrangements. **Attendees are responsible for covering their own lodging arrangements.** (There is a local host hotel with a conference rate - details will be available when registration opens.)*

What information should applicants provide?

- Name, affiliation, and contact information
- Summary of interest in the conference and how the grant will help with attendance
- Estimated travel costs (indicating what part of costs could be covered by other resources)
- Letter of support from your current or future institution (optional, but encouraged)

When and where to submit?

Please submit your information through the [Travel Grant Form](#) by **March 20, 2026**. (Note: this deadline is after paper acceptance notification.)

When will decisions be made?

We expect to make decisions about the travel grants by April 10th, 2026 and will notify recipients by email.
